Nothing in this subdivision shall be construed to permit the closure of a meeting merely because an attorney representing the public body is in attendance or is consulted on a matter; (Consultation with city attorney concerning Wright and Bond v City of Bristol, et al); and Executive Session pursuant to § 2.2-3711.A.1, Code of Virginia 1950, as amended. Discussion, consideration, or interviews of prospective candidates for employment; assignment, appointment, promotion, performance, demotion, salaries, disciplining, or resignation of specific public officers, appointees, or employees of any public body; (Appointment to Transportation Safety Commission).
