PUBLIC NOTICE

DISPOSAL OF UNCLAIMED BICYCLES

Pursuant to 15.2-1719, 15.2-1720 of the Virginia Code and 86-283 Bristol Code of Ordinance, notice is hereby given that the unclaimed bicycles listed below, which have been acquired by law enforcement officers pursuant to their duties, and have been in the possession of the Bristol Virginia Police Department for more than sixty days, will be auctioned off after the expiration of thirty (30) days following the date of this notice. If no bid for such sale is made at the sale, the police Chief may donate such bicycle to a welfare or charitable organization, or discard it as junk.

Anyone who in good faith believes that he or she is the rightful owner of one more of said bicycle(s) and desires to view and inspect the same will be permitted to do so upon presenting a claim of ownership thereof together with a detailed description of the bicycle and sufficient documentation to support such claim.
